PARENT AGREEMENT:

I certify that my child is fully capable of participating in camp activities. I understand that there are inherent risks, including serious physical injury and death associated with camp activities. I understand that the directors and members of Merri-Mac & Timberlake, LLC exercise extreme caution in the conduct of all camp activities; however, I understand they do not assume responsibility for accidents or illness suffered by Merri-Mac & Timberlake, LLC campers. I certify that all medical expenses resulting from an injury to my child requiring the attention of a physician are my responsibility and that any billing statements issued for treatment of such an injury will be forwarded to me or to my insurance company. In consideration of Camp Timberlake's acceptance of the camper, I, the undersigned parent or guardian, agree to indemnify and hold harmless Merri-Mac & Timberlake, LLC and its members or employees from any loss resulting from injury or illness to the camper.

I understand the directors of Merri-Mac & Timberlake reserve the right to dismiss, without refund, any camper whose influence is detrimental to the operation of the camp, as determined by the discretion of the directors. I understand that the use of alcohol, tobacco products, and illegal drugs is strictly prohibited on all Merri-Mac, Timberlake & TWA programs. I agree to allow my child's possessions to be searched for these and other detrimental items at the discretion of the directors.

REFUND POLICY:

The camp fee is \$4,950 for five weeks, \$4,500 for four, \$3,500 for 20 Day, \$2,450 for two weeks, and \$1,150 for Short Term. A \$400 deposit is required to reserve a spot for your child. The deposit is applicable to the tuition and is, in the event of withdrawal, refundable (less a \$100 processing charge) if written notice is received by the camp office by **March 1**. No refunds will be made after **March 1, whether for withdrawal, session changes, or paid balances**, except in the event of documented physical illness of the camper, and in that in such event, 50% of the unused portion of the tuition will be refunded. The balance of the camp fee is due by **April 1**, and the nonrefundable horseback riding fee is to be paid at the time of your deposit.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

We accept any payment by check and deposits by Visa or Mastercard. In either case, your deposit plus any applicable fees is due with the application, and your remaining balance is due no later than April 1. Please remit the remaining balance by check. IMPORTANT NOTE

This form, when returned to us, is only an application. It does not automatically guarantee or reserve a spot at camp. We fill very quickly and maintain a waiting list for each session, each year. Your camper will be officially enrolled when you receive your confirmation letter from camp. If your session is full, you will be placed on a waiting list and your deposit will not be processed.

Thank you for your application. A summer spent at camp is a treasure your child will enjoy and benefit from for the rest of his life, and we appreciate the opportunity to serve you by giving your child the best summer possible!

Age Limit: 7 - 16 years. Enrollment is limited, and early enrollment is advised.

Camp Season: The first full session (1F), five weeks, for 2009 starts June 7th and ends July 10th. The first session consists of a Short Term for first year campers only starting June 7th and ending June 12th; a 20 day term (1A) starting on June 7th and ending June 26th; a 14 day session (1B) starting on June 13th and ending on June 26th; and a 14 day session (1C) starting on June 27th and ending on July 10th and a 28 day session (1D) starting on June 13th and ending July 10th. The second session consists of two 14 day sessions. The first session (2A) starts on July 12th and ends on July 25th; the second session (2B) starts on July 26th and ends on August 8th. The first session closing ceremony will begin at 4:30 pm on July 9th. The second session closing ceremony will begin at 4:30 pm on August 7th. For campers departing on June 12th, June 26th, and July 25th there will be no formal closing. We suggest parting time be around the noon hour, if possible.

Camp Fees: The cost for the first session (1F), five weeks, is \$4,950. First session's Short Term fee is \$1,150; 20 day term (1A) is \$3,500; 14 day terms (1B or 1C) of first session cost \$2,450 each and the 28 day term (1D) of first session is \$4,500. The second session fee (2F), four weeks is \$4,500. The 14 day terms (2A or 2B) of second session cost \$2,450 each. This includes laundry service, all activity supplies, craft materials, and all other camp fees with the exception of horseback riding, clothing, paintball and special requests.

Please Note: No allowance will be made for late arrivals or early withdrawals except in the event of documented physical illness. In such case the loss will be shared equally by the camp and the camper's parents. The fee for early arrivals or late departures is \$150.00 per day.

Registration: Timberlake enrollment is limited to 100 campers. Applications will be processed in the order that they are received. All applications must be filled out completely and mailed with a \$400.00 registration fee. This fee is applicable to the tuition and is, in the event of withdrawal, refundable (less a \$100.00 processing charge) if written notice is received by the camp office by March 1. No refunds will be made after March 1, whether for withdrawal, session change, or paid balance, except in the event of documented physical illness of the camper. In such event, 50% of the unused portion of the tuition will be refunded to the parent. The balance of the camp fee will be paid by April 1.

Policies: Every camper should understand and willingly agree to abide by the camp regulations and policies in order that no misunderstandings may arise during the camp season. Smoking, drinking and the use of drugs are not permitted at camp. Timberlake reserves the right to dismiss without refund any camper or staff member whose influence is considered detrimental to the overall camp program. Timberlake may use any camper's image or photo for promotional materials.

Care Packages: Food items should not be sent to campers.

Camp Baggage: Many of our parents drive to camp with their campers' trunks. If you would like to mail camper baggage it should be sent to Timberlake at least one week prior to the session start. All baggage should be addressed to: Camp Timberlake for Boys, 1123 Montreat Road, Black Mountain, NC 28711. **Proper identification should be on all baggage. We will be happy to return baggage via UPS or FedEx, if requested, for a \$80 per parcel fee. Oversize packages will be billed accordingly.**

Camp Needs: Timberlake laundry bags and T-shirts may be purchased at the camp trading post or may be ordered prior to arrival at camp through forms sent with the Spring information sheets.

Camp laundry is done weekly by cabins and is returned the same day. All articles must be marked clearly with the camper's name. Timberlake does not assume responsibility for lost articles. Printed or sewn nametags are recommended.

What Happens Next? Every effort is made to review an application the day it is received. After camp accepts an application, we send out a confirmation letter listing your camper(s) and session(s). In April, we publish our "Camper Packet" on our web site. It can be downloaded from our "files and forms" page. This packet will contain important forms and all the details you need to get ready for camp. Additionally, there are several important deadlines in the Spring. March 1 is the latest date we are able to offer refunds for the coming summer, and balances must be paid in full by April 1. Any time you have a question, please call our camp office - we are happy to help you with your summer plans. You may also find much useful information on our web site, including "frequently asked question" pages and many images of camp.
